Beware of fraudsters impersonating
Guotai Junan International Holdings Limited and its subsidiaries

Guotai Junan International Holdings Limited and GTJAI subsidiaries (collectively “the Group”) and the Group’s parent company, Guotai Haitong Securities Co., Ltd., have in recent respectively received inquiries regarding a suspected fraud. It is alleged that certain individuals, under the guise of the “Healthy China Centennial Plan”, are exploiting elderly people’s concerns about health and desire for secure retirement by impersonating the Group and its parent company and promoting the project as capable of delivering substantial investment returns extensively.

The Group hereby solemnly declares that the aforementioned scam are carried out by others impersonating the Group and its parent company to engage in illegal securities activities and are unrelated to the Group. We urge everyone to remain vigilant and not to participate in the aforementioned investment activities. In addition, the Group also reminds all clients and investors to pay attention to following matters and exercise caution to avoid falling into victims to deception.
